ELECTRONIC VOTING

Due to COVID and remote working arrangements, the HUCTW Elections Committee has decided to hold the 2022 Negotiating Team Election via Electronic Voting. All votes must be delivered via electronic ballots, there is no exception to this.

- **For contested elections, each eligible HUCTW voter will be emailed a unique access link to an electronic ballot** which will allow a member to vote in the election that they are eligible to vote in. Members may also request to have their ballot link texted to them.
- **Online voting will take place March 8–9, 2022.**
- **The HUCTW Elections Committee will review and publish results by Thursday, March 10, 2022.**
